



## **Driver Action Card for Retrieve Overnight Vehicle**

This brief must be given verbally to the escorting hospital team prior to departure It is mandatory and must take less than 2 minutes

Driver actions	Manage loading of trolley using winch and ramp
(pre-transfer)	Connect to power and vehicle oxygen
	Unstow crew seats
	Brief team as below, including radio use and confirming channel
Crew Brief	Safety
	Remain seated and seatbelted while vehicle in motion
	Communication
	Ask to stop (using radio/alarm) if need to move from seat
	Advice

	Equipment
	Confirm inverter on and functioning after ignition turned on
	Location of oxygen flowmeter
	• State: oxygen supply is 2250L before we need to stop and switch cylinders; ask: <b>is this enough?</b>
	Indicate labelled cupboards of consumables
	Indicate location of Emergency Action Card folder
	Do the clinical team have any questions?
Driver actions (pre-repatriation)	Clean clinical cabin
	On return of clinical team to vehicle
	Confirm their equipment is clean
	Confirm they have all equipment and drugs
	Confirm they have the paper transfer record to leave in the ROV form box
	Load equipment and unstow seats for team
	Did the team use any consumables during transfer?
	Replenish suction if used.
